

## CLINICAL QUIZ (p118) ANSWER

Case 1:

- (a) Moonface, hirsutism and "buffalo" hump; or Cushingoid features.
- (b) Cushingoid features – probably due to steroid therapy.

Case 2:

- (a) Swelling/mass/tumour-like swelling over medial aspect of left upper thigh and outer aspect of shoulder. Purplish-blue discoloration and swelling of lower lip.
- (b) Liver enlargement (due to haemangioma) and petechiae (due to platelet-consumption – Kasabach-Merritt syndrome).
- (c) Multiple cavernous haemangiomas.
