Case 1 (Figures 1a & 1b)

An 8-month-old infant was found to have multiple erythematous exudative lesions over his face (Figure 1a) and back (Figure 1b). The lesions started as an apparent isolated insect bite over his right cheek 5 days ago.

Case 2 (Figure 2)

An 8-year-old boy with a preceding history of sore throat 7 days ago was noted to have low-grade fever (38.5°C) and general malaise associated with multiple erythematous lesions over his lower limbs and buttock of 2 days duration (Figure 2). They were not itchy and did not fade on pressure.
